# **CASE STUDY**

### HOMES FOR HARINGEY

Homes for Haringey (HFH) manages around 16,000 tenanted properties and 4,500 leasehold properties for the London Borough of Haringey. As part of this role, HFH have responsibility for all repairs and asset management programmes, as well as involvement in managing the procurement of these programmes. HFH realised their procurement documentation was not fit for purpose and required updating as it still reflected out of date contracts, superseded legislation and alterations for project-specific items. HFH was mindful that a review would require expertise on the new JCT contracts and an understanding of EU procurement law. Chris reviewed the template tender documentation, including the following tasks:

- Updated HFH's standard Invitation to Tender to reflect the Public Contract Regs 2015;
- Updated HFH's standard Selection Questionnaire to include questions regarding economic, professional and technical experience;
- Developed an Information Memorandum including evaluation information and marking grid to be used with the Selection Questionnaire;

- Incorporated the new JCT Measured Term Contract 2016 by reviewing HFH's standard amendments for JCT MTC 2011, reporting on market suitability of certain amendments, updated compliance issues and suggesting best practice amendments;
- Recommended amendments to the pricing documents to adequately cover potential differing service requirements: (i) planned and responsive maintenance (ii) planned only (iii) responsive only;
- Provided guidance notes to officers on changes to be made for differing service requirements;
- Developed two separate "tender packs", one each for Open and Restricted procurement.

"Chris was able to suggest simplifications to the tender packs so that the documents could be easily converted into a formal contract by officers. It is expected this approach will bring cash savings to Homes for Haringey and lead to timely preparation and more control over the contracting process. Chris' work reflects an in-depth knowledge of construction and procurement law coupled with experience of dealing with challenges in tendering processes and solution focus."
